The Pottery is crafted by him and relatives by hand and with gifts from mother earth as colors and rustic and natural implements, creating Clay Pots, Jars, Vases, Pitchers, whistle, etc.

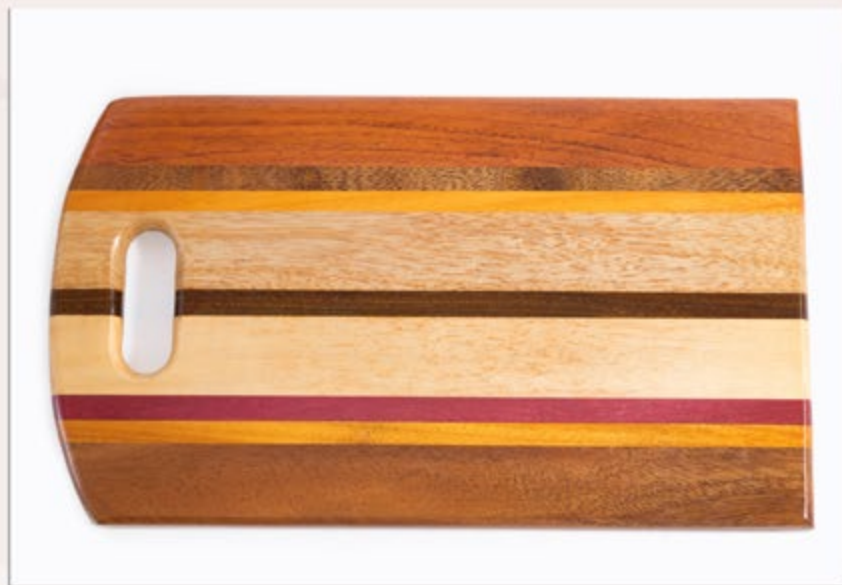

Rodolfo Uder, born in Costa Rica in 1955, completed his graduate Engineering Degree in Agronomy at the University of Sao Paulo in Brazil, South America. On his return to Costa Rica he dedicated his efforts transforming 630 acres of denude, degraded, over grazed pastures and hills into a successful model of managed reforestation and secondary regeneration of natural forest in the extensive dry tropical Pacific area of Costa Rica.

In 1992, Mr Uder began collecting this otherwise wasted wood and began creating his magnificent lathe turned, wooden art forms, made only from trees that himself planted or from naturally fallen trees.
